

# Reflective Statement Analysis Guide

## A. Purpose and Focus.

- How or why do you think the evidence cited in the reflective statement is special to the writer?
- Which 'organizer' and 'aspect' do you believe is the best fit for the evidence presented and discussed?

## B. The Reflection.

- What has the writer learned about himself/herself from the experience(s) associated with the evidence?
- Identify specific skills, attributes, attitudes that have been discussed or demonstrated via the reflective statement....
- Did the writer face any particular challenges in being able to 'demonstrate' the evidence? Is the context sufficient to understand the meaning of the learning that is represented?
- How does the writer feel about what the evidence represents and why?
